### UNIT 4: God Guides His People

As God's people continued their wilderness journey, they failed to believe in the Lord's promise to work for their good by giving them the land of Canaan. The Israelites' disobedience, grumbling, doubting, and complaining demonstrated their unbelief. Yet, God was faithful to guide His people and raise up a new leader—Joshua—who would lead the next generation of Israelites into the Promised Land.

**Big Picture Question:** Why should we obey God? We should obey God because He made us, He loves us, and His plans are good.

Rentals will be online through your registration, or in cash onsite. If you plan on renting, you can pre-pay through JHC to speed up the process if you would like.

Skates are \$3.50/each and Helmets are \$1.75/each. Everyone 12 years and younger must be wearing a helmet on the ice. Strollers and wheelchairs are allowed on the ice, they just ask that the tires are wiped clean and the person in the carrier is wearing a helmet. They do have xxs helmets.
