Genesis 10-11

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO SIN? TO SIN IS TO THINK, SAY, OR BEHAVE IN ANY WAY THAT GOES AGAINST GOD AND HIS COMMANDS.

After the great flood, God told Noah and his sons to grow their families and fill the earth. One day, the people traveled through a valley. They liked it there and decided to stay.

"We don't want to be scattered all over the earth," they said. "Let's build a city and a tower so big that it touches the sky. The tower will make us famous!"

They wanted glory for themselves instead of God. But God is greater than anyone. God created people to give glory to Him alone.

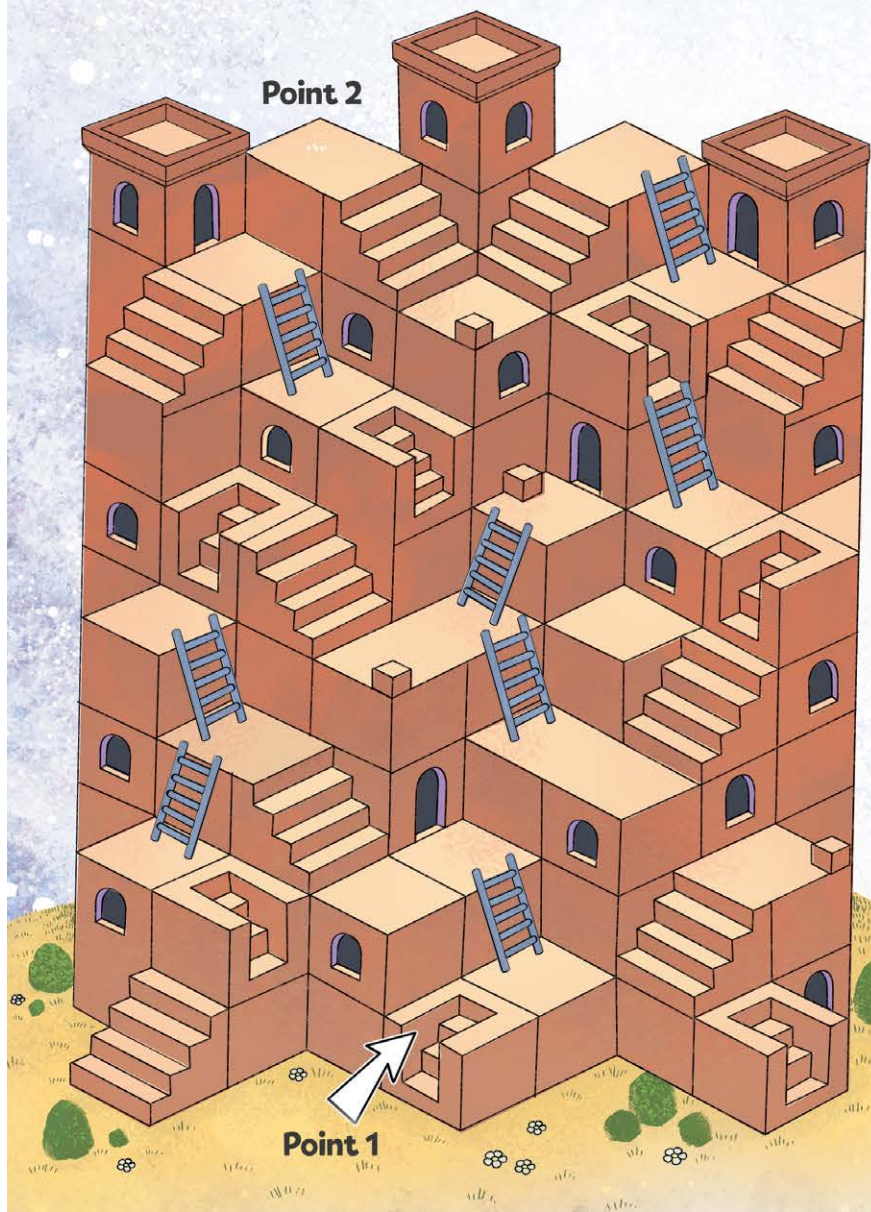

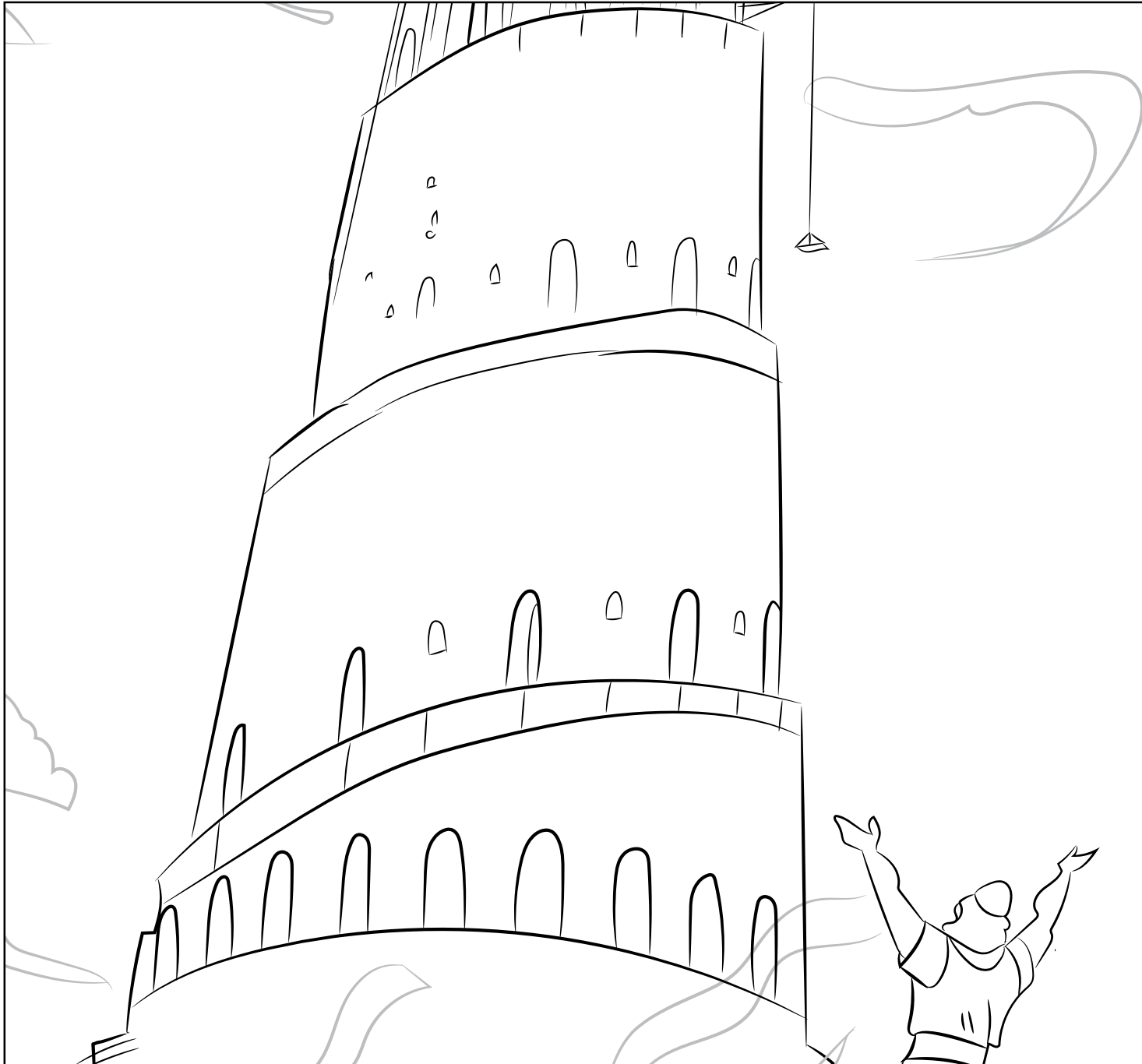
CHRIST CONNECTION:
